


DID YOU KNOW?

WA USES 13 BILLION DRINK CONTAINERS EVERY 10 YEARS.

That's enough to fill Optus Stadium 3 times. Don't let your containers end up in landfill.





Based on standard 600ml container filling approx. Optus stadium volume of 3 million cubic metres multiplied over 10.4 years.

TARGETING LITTER AND LANDFILL

Containers for Change targets the beverage containers that are commonly littered. This includes plastic and glass bottles, liquid paperboard cartons, and steel and aluminium cans.

Together we can keep these 10¢ containers out of landfill, give them another life, and help our community while doing it.


